Meet in the hotel lobby at 12:45 pm. The bus will leave the Arizona Biltmore Hotel promptly at 1:00 pm and will arrive at the McDowell Sonoran Preserve at the Lost Dog Wash Trailhead by 2:00 pm. The bus will leave the Sunrise Trailhead at 4:30 pm and arrive back at the Arizona Biltmore around 5:30 pm.

Cost

While there is no fee to participate in the hike, you must register in advance by completing this form.

Hike

The hike will be at the McDowell Sonoran Preserve. The buses will drop hikers at the Lost Dog Wash Trailhead. People can hike the Ringtail Trail to the Sunrise Trail (5.5 mi) with the option of veering off halfway in to hike to the scenic view (out and back). The scenic view adds an additional 2.4 miles to the hike (total 7.9 mi). The bus will pick up hikers at the Sunrise Trailhead, where the trail ends. This hike is moderate to difficult. Sunrise trail has over an 1,100 foot elevation change. Sunrise Peak is one of very few Preserve peaks with a trail to the top, from which you can see expansive views of the McDowell Mountains in all directions and beautiful granite formations.

For those hikers that want a less challenging hike, they can hike around the Lost Dog Overlook Trail loop to the Taliesin Overlook and report back to the bus drop-off point (total miles 5.9 mi). The bus can swing back by the Lost Dog Wash Trailhead on the way back to the hotel to pick up hikers who decided to stay in this area. This hike is easy. Lost Dog Wash Trailhead offers somewhat shorter and easier trails that wander around and across a natural desert wash. A gentle out-and-back hike that crosses several small washes, Taliesin Overlook has extensive views northwest and looks down onto Frank Lloyd Wright's Taliesin West, his winter home and school.

Suggestions for Hikers

Wear appropriate hiking shoes, and bring a backpack to carry any items needed on the hike. The path can be rocky at times. If you are running the trail, make sure your footing is stable on the gravel/rocky parts. Wear appropriate clothing. It may be cool in Phoenix that day if it is windy. The views are really beautiful, so feel free to bring a camera or cellphone with a camera. If you decide to drive your own personal vehicle in lieu of using the bus, a vehicle parking fee may apply.

Note

Extra water, sunscreen and sunglasses are recommended.
