## CLE Information & State Approvals

As the conference will take place virtually this year, we have applied for two different types of CLE credit: “live” and “on-demand.” Please note, approvals and restrictions vary by state, so check the approval chart below to see what your jurisdiction will allow. We will be monitoring attendance through the virtual platform we are using and post-conference, the process will be the same as it has been since 2016.

All attendees seeking Continuing Legal Education (CLE) credits will receive an email on **Thursday, October 29**, with a link to add jurisdiction(s) and bar number(s), confirm sessions and obtain a Certificate of Attendance. You must do this by **Friday, November 6** for ICSC to report your credits for you (where applicable). If you do not complete by the deadline and are in jurisdiction(s) where ICSC reports for you, you will need to self-file instead.

### During the Conference

The virtual conference platform will monitor the sessions you attend and, depending on your state, you may receive approval for both live and on-demand sessions. Please make sure to check the chart for restrictions.

- **Live sessions** – must be attended in full during their scheduled dates and times between **October 14-16, 2020**
- **On-demand sessions** – these will be available for viewing until **October 23, 2020**. If you would like CLE credit for them, you must watch them and provide the code that shows up during the session to [jquinn@icsc.com](mailto:jquinn@icsc.com) by **October 23**. The general sessions, seminars and workshops will be offered on-demand after they run live. Please note that Peer to Peer sessions will not be available on-demand.

### After the Conference

Confirm your attendance and retrieve your Certificate of Attendance

- You will receive an email with a link to log in to the CLE system.
- Log in with your last name and email address.
- Confirm your contact information and enter your jurisdiction(s).
- Download your Certificate(s) of Attendance.

### After Retrieving Your Certificate

- Review the credit reporting information below for your jurisdiction(s).
- If supplemental forms print out with your Certificate, submit them to the appropriate jurisdiction(s).
- Self-file your attendance where applicable.

- In most jurisdictions, ICSC will report your credits for you! Review the credit reporting information below for your jurisdiction(s).
- If you do not confirm your attendance by the deadline given in the email, you will need to self-file with your jurisdiction(s).

## State Approvals

ICSC has applied to the following state bars for CLE approval of 675 minutes of total live instruction, inclusive of 600 minutes of Ethics instruction, 150 minutes of Diversity & Inclusion (for some states) and 150 minutes of Tech (for some states) excluding breaks, and networking opportunities. ICSC has also applied for 4,725 minutes of total on-demand instruction. In order to get credit for on-demand, you must watch your sessions by October 23.

### Calculate Your Credits:

The total credits listed below reflect the maximum number of credits an attendee can earn at the 2020 U.S. Law Conference, including the maximum Ethics, Diversity & Inclusion (where applicable) and Tech credits (where applicable) for that jurisdiction. Pending approval, in 60-minute states, every 60-minutes of instruction is equal to 1.0 credit. In 50-minute states, every 50-minutes of instruction is equal to 1.2 credit. 50-minute states are designated with an asterisk (\*) below.
