

# 2024 CLE Information and State Approvals

Please note, approvals and restrictions vary by state, so check the approval chart below to see what your jurisdiction will allow.

All attendees seeking Continuing Legal Education (CLE) credits will receive an email on **Tuesday, November 5, 2024** with a link to add jurisdiction(s) and bar number(s), confirm sessions and obtain a Certificate of Attendance. You must do this by **Friday, November 15, 2024, at 3:00 pm ET** for ICSC to report your credits for you (where applicable). If you do not complete by the deadline and are in jurisdiction(s) where ICSC reports for you, you will need to self-file instead.

### At the Conference

### Let the RFID tags on your badge holders do the work for you!

- RFID Radio Frequency Identification tags track your attendance at the sessions only; nowhere else.
- No tapping, no scanning, just walk through the session door.

# **State Approvals**

ICSC has applied to the following state bars for CLE approval of 780 minutes of total live instruction, including 660 minutes of Ethics instruction, 120 minutes of Diversity & Inclusion instruction (for some states), 60 minutes of Professionalism instruction (for some states), 180 minutes of Competency/Substance Abuse instruction (for some states), and 300 minutes of Tech/Cybersecurity instruction (for some states).
