2026 CLE Information and State Approvals

Please note that approvals and restrictions vary by state, so check the chart below to see what your jurisdiction will allow.

All attendees seeking Continuing Legal Education (CLE) credit will receive an email the morning of **Wednesday, October 21, 2026**, with a link to the CLE Online Platform. Through the CLE Online Platform, attendees can add their jurisdiction(s) and bar number(s), track their sessions in real time, and obtain a Certificate of Attendance. Attendees who wish to have ICSC report CLE credits on their behalf (where applicable) must login to the CLE Online Platform and verify that all their information is correct no later than **Friday, October 30, 2026, at 5:00 pm ET**. If you do not login and verify by the deadline and are in any jurisdiction(s) where ICSC reports for you, you will have to self-file instead.

At the Conference

Let the RFID tags encoded in your badges do the work for you!

- RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) tags track your attendance at the sessions only – nowhere else.
- For Peer-to-Peer and Symposia sessions, lightly wave or tap your badge on the scanners placed at the marked session doorways, both when entering and exiting the rooms.
- For all other sessions, no tapping or scanning is required – just walk through the marked session doorways!

- You will receive an email with a link to access the CLE System.
- Login with your name and email address.
- Verify your contact information and enter your jurisdiction(s) and bar number(s).
